Alburrica Beach Windmills
In 1852, three windmills were built in Alburrica: The East Windmill, fully rebuilt in 2018, the West and the Giant.
Location: Praia de Alburrica

Jim's Mill
Built in 1827 by James Hartley, known as "Jim". A truncated cone shaped mill, with a three stories tower, a gyrotory canopy and two grinding wheels. The original sail system was inspired by the Dutch technology-rectangular wooden sails.

Urban Art Vhils
Right in the heart of the former Companhia de União Fabril, the mural created by **Vhils** (Alexandre Farto), dedicated to the company workers, is in focus.
Location: Rua da CUF and Rua Industrial Alfredo da Silva

Alfredo da Silva Mausoleum
An unique funerary sculpture in Barreiro, inaugurated in 1944, as part of a project from the architect Luís Cristino da Silva with bas reliefs created by the sculptor Leopoldo de Almeida.
Location: Rua Industrial Alfredo da Silva, N. 10

Espaço Memória
Espaço Memória presents us with an exhibition about Barreiro history, addressing the role of the county in the Discoveries, the wind and tidal mills, the railroads install, the cork and the Companhia União Fabril until the Carnation Revolution.
Location: Rua 17th, n. 10 (Baía Tejo- Business Park)

Industrial Museum
Displays the largest industrial complex of the Iberian Peninsula: the Companhia União Fabril, in its different valences chemical, textile and social, among others.
Location: Rua 44th, n. 29-25 (Baía Tejo-Business Park)

Working Class Neighbourhood
Working Class Neighbourhood of Santa Bárbara, built between 1909 and 1927, to accommodate CUF workers.
Location: Rua da CUF (Baía Tejo- Business Park)
